Inside poisons that kill cats¹

- Antifreeze
- Detergents
- Dog tick and flea shampoos/products
- Detol used on the cat's skin
- Detol products and sprays
- Disinfectants – always rinse clean
- Bleach – always rinse clean
- Lavender oil
- Tea Tree oil
- Eucalyptus oil
- Asprin
- Panadol and human pain relief drugs
- Antidepressants / psychotropic medicines
- Cancer drugs
- Vitamins and supplements
- Alcohol
- Coffee and products with caffeine
- Chocolate
- Garlic
- Grapes
- Yeast
- Cut flowers in the home eg tulips, lilies, chrysanthemum



Outside poisons that kill cats¹

- Ratsack
- Lily plants (contact can kill in 3 days)
- Poinsettia
- Insect sprays and herbicides

Other household harms

- Water features and ponds may drown a kitten
- Washing machine and dryer (where kittens hide)
- Toilet seats left up may drown a kitten
- Furniture (a kitchen chair) tipped over by a child has killed a WLPA adopted kitten
- Thumb tacs (foot injury and ingestion)
- String, rubber bands and dental floss (ingestion)
- Chicken bones (raw and cook pose choke risk)
